- F. Motion made by Blake Cooper seconded by Travis Potts to approve the issuing of RFPs for Engineering and Construction on the upcoming Hwy 515 sewer line replacements. Motion carried unanimously.
- G. Motion made by Blake Cooper seconded by Jacob Roan to reappoint Jason Jarrett to the Planning and Zoning Commission. Motion carried unanimously.

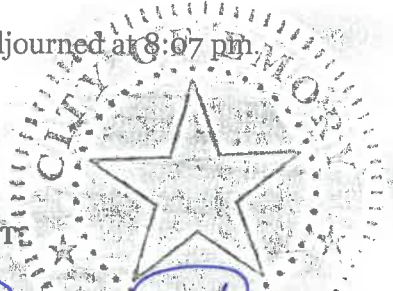
**Executive Session**
