Regular Agenda Items:

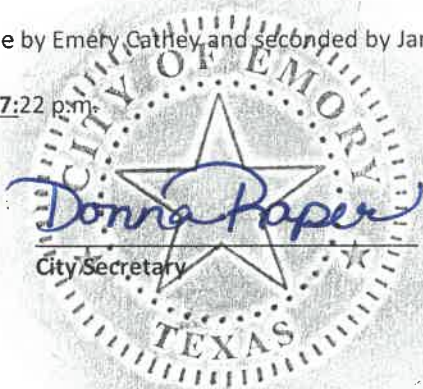
